- We endeavor to develop balanced young people by teaching, instilling & up-holding the Club's Values and Culture.
- We will provide an unrivaled level of exposure to the professional game.
- All staff members will work together to support the needs of the players toward the common goal of creating a pathway from the Academy to the highest level possible.
- The Boca Juniors approach to teaching soccer is a proven methodology that has produced many of the world's greatest professional players.
- Boca Juniors GUARANTEES the best training sessions. We DO NOT GUARANTEE gaming time. Every player needs to earn their spot on every game based on the Coach's decision (this applies to any kind of game; scrimmage, League or tournament).

Players

- All practices are MANDATORY. Do not expect to play if you don't attend practice. Mandatory assistance: 90% of the training sessions.
- Be on time. At least 15 minutes before training starts.
- Wear training gear to every practice. Team T-Shirt, Shorts, & Warm-up.
- Bring running shoes and cleats to every practice.
- Wear shin guards and soccer socks. MANDATORY.
- Warm-up starts exactly at specified training time.
- Social conversations will only be allowed before training, during water breaks, and after practice.
- During water breaks we jog to get water and we jog when we are called back to our next drill.
- If you are injured, you are still expected to be at trainings, games, and tournaments unless other arrangements have been made with the coach.
- If you cannot continue to train because of an injury, you are to approach the coach to let him know your problem.
- Never confront anyone, especially referees, other team players or staff.
- Do not speak with anyone but coaching staff.
- Respect your coach, teammates, and parents.
- No talking back to anyone on the coaching staff. If you have any questions or concerns please speak with the coach. There is no place for bad attitudes on this team.
- Work to improve your personal abilities everyday at training and at home.
- If you have any issues I encourage you (the player) to talk to the coach. He is here to HELP you so he will be available for you. It could be anything.
- It is better to discuss something that concerns you than to let it continue to bother you.
- Attendance will be taken. Good attendance can help you. Bad attendance can hurt you.
- If you cannot make training, you must email or call us in advance. Contact information: info@usboca.com or 516 780 7077
- Players who abuse the rules will be informed or warned and if it continued, there will be repercussions.
- Conduct yourself like a good citizen on and off the field. How you carry yourself is a reflection on us as the coaches.
- Always check your email to see if there are any changes to any schedule. Our main source of communication is through email/ app.
- NO CELL PHONES/IPODS at trainings, games, team meetings or tournaments while we are together as a team. You must wait until dismissed.
- Be on time! Everyone needs to be at the field 60 minutes before the game starts! Be dressed and ready to start warm-ups 45 minutes before the game starts! Warm-ups start 30 minutes before the game. No fooling around 45 minutes before the game. Get focused on what you have to do in the game mentally.

Parents

- You need to respect all rules if you want to be a part of Boca Juniors. If you do not, your son/ daughter can be expelled from the team.
- All practices are MANDATORY. Do not expect your kid to play if he doesn't attend practice. Mandatory assistance: 90% of the training sessions.
- Be on time. At least 15 minutes before training starts.
- We encourage the players to communicate with their coach, so we would appreciate if you refrain from providing your personal feedback. Parents are not allowed to talk to the coach.
- Respect other parents and all players.
- Parents need to be on the opposite sideline from the coach.
- Respect the team players/ staff and the opponent's team players/ staff as well.
- You are not allowed to talk to the referee at any time.
- Only encourage the team, never encourage one specific player.
- Do not instruct any player, including your son/ daughter.
- Never insult others. If you do, your son/daughter will be expelled from the team. No questions asked. No refund.

Cancellation Policy: To Cancel the membership; please fill the "Refund Request Form". Voluntary Withdrawal: Up to 50% of remaining proportional value. The maximum refund will be of the amount of \$500 total. Involuntary Withdrawal due to Injury- Credit for future programs at the academy such as Camps/Clinics can be given when a player has sustained a serious injury while participating with a Boca Juniors activity. Camps/Clinics/Programs (excluding international trips): Voluntary Withdrawal - Refund in full 30 days prior to program start date with \$150 administrative cost. 75% Refund 29 to 7 days prior to program start date (a \$200 fee will be charged as an administration cost) . 50% Refund 6 days prior to program start date (a \$300 fee will be charged as an administration cost). No refund 5 days prior to program starting. No prorations of any kind will be applied once the program has started. If the player decides to leave the academy/programs/camps/clinics for any particular reason that is not medically related, you need to notify us by email to refund@usboca.com 30 days in advance. If the player is on an installment payment plan, you will be charged until 30 days after your notification is received by email. Refund process may take up to 8 weeks to process if approved.

Payment Methods: We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover credit cards plus personal checks and money orders as forms of payment. By submitting an order through our Sites, you authorize Boca Juniors or its designated payment processor, to charge the account you specify for the purchase amount. All payments are to be made in United States Dollars. When you provide your credit card number to us, you authorize us to store your credit card number and related payment information. When paying by check/ cash your place is not confirmed in the program until the physical check/ cash has been received and deposited. All online payment transactions are processed securely through BOCA JUNIORS LLC on www.usboca.com using PayPal or the designated payment gateway on behalf of Boca Juniors. I agree that I am entering an agreement with Boca Juniors to provide me with services and understand that Boca Juniors are handling my secure transaction. My credit card statement will detail the payment transaction through Boca Juniors LLC. I understand that I have registered for any that Boca Juniors will conduct.

Weather Policy: If a class is cancelled by Boca Juniors due to adverse weather conditions we will do our best to make up all lost time. Refunds will not be issued in the case of weather cancellations. Unfortunately, predicting the weather is not a perfect science and while we endeavor to make the correct call, we know that we can't please everyone all of the time. In the event of light showers all programs will continue as scheduled, providing the playing area is safe. Parents should dress their child appropriately for the weather conditions, as sessions will go ahead regardless of damp weather, providing the coach deems the playing area safe to continue.

Waiver and Hold Harmless Agreement - Boca Juniors: When you register with Boca Juniors directly or via www.usboca.com you agree to the following:

You agree to list all additional medical information by enclosing additional written documentation when registering or two weeks after. I hereby agree to let my son/daughter participate in the sport of soccer. I understand that there are certain risks of injury inherent in the practice and play of this sport, as well as in traveling and other related activities incidental to my participation, and am willing to assume these risks. I hereby certify that he/she is fully capable of participating in the sport of soccer and that he/she is healthy and has no physical or mental disabilities or infirmities that would restrict full participation in this activity, except as included in writing with this application. In addition to giving full consent for my son/daughter participation, I do hereby waive, release and hold harmless Boca Juniors, its officers, coaches, sponsors, supervisors and representatives for any injury that may be suffered by my son/daughter in the normal course of participation in the sport of soccer and the activities incidental thereto, whether the result of negligence or any other cause. I grant permission for my son/daughter to receive emergency medical treatment. I grant Boca Juniors permission to use photographic or video images for promotional reasons. Boca Juniors has the power to expel any player or parent in case of not respecting the rules described in our philosophy and code of conduct; Boca also has the right to terminate the contract with the player for any cause by paying the maximum amount described in the cancellation clause.
